Canteen Volunteers Needed

Achilles has a Stand Easy period in the middle of our cadet night, Stand Easy is a break period between classes. During Stand Easy in the past we have ran a Canteen where we sell drinks and snacks to the cadets, they are also welcome to bring their own. Money raised will go towards Christmas and Year End Parties or trips. To have the Canteen, we need Parent Volunteers to come out each Friday to run the Canteen for us. Our goal is to have 2 parents come out each week, the more volunteers we have the better. Sign up sheet will be at the front door at Drop off and at Pick up, hoping to start Canteen in October.

Tuesday Training

In October we will be starting back to our voluntary extra training on Tuesday Evenings. Tuesday nights are not mandatory. The Tuesday training is a rotating training for our competition teams, First Aid, Drill, Seamanship and Semaphore. Normally we have Squadron competitions with other Corps in the area in late winter, this hasn't been confirmed yet but we wanted to get a head start. All cadets are welcome they are not required to try all teams just the ones that are interesting to them. Tuesday Training will start Oct 4th (Seamanship & First Aid) and Oct 11th (Drill & Semaphore)

Saturday Onboard Training – Oct 22nd

We will be having a Saturday training Day, this is just extra training and a fun day, we will also be preparing for Remembrance Day. Cadets are to attend in Civilian attire, and we are asking them to bring their own lunch and snacks for this training. Refillable Water bottles are also required. Further details on this training day will be forthcoming.

Poppy Campaign

The Poppy Campaign is held the last weekend of October (28, 29 & 30) and first Weekend of November (4, 5 & 6). The goal of the Poppy Campaign is to have all Canadians wearing a Poppy for Remembrance Day, they do not have to donate to receive a Poppy, but donations are welcome. Cadets will be asked to sign up for 4 shifts. There will be 1 shift Friday, 3 shifts Saturday and 1 shift Sunday

- Friday 1800 – 2100
- Saturday Market 0700 - 1000
- Saturday 0800-1100, 1000 – 1300, 1300-1600
- Sunday 1300 - 1600

An email with a link for sign up will be sent out closer to the start date. Each family is required to drop their cadet at an assigned location and time. An officer will meet you at that location with a Poppy Box and explain how things work. If you can stay and supervise, please check the box on the online form. More details will be emailed closer to the date.

Remembrance Day

This year the Remembrance Day Service is returning to the usual format. This is a mandatory event, but we are aware that Remembrance Day falls on a Friday this year and there are some that may not be able to attend. If your cadet is not able to attend, please let the Corps know. NLCC Achilles will be participating

in the City's services. We will be meeting at the Armory in the morning and marching over to the Sleeman Centre with the Senior Corps, Veterans, Reservist and such. We will be participating in the Service and forming a living cross during the ceremony. Cadets will seat with the Corps, parents can attend but must seat in their own section not with the cadets. After the service there is normally a parade from the Sleeman's Centre by the Cenotaph through downtown and back the Armory where you will meet your cadet(s). Specific timings and details will be provided closer to the date. Jackets will be provided to the cadets for this event.
